Which Champions Tour player once did a photo shoot with one Mary Cathleen Collins (Bo Derek)? – **John Cook.**

Which former Champions Tour player holds the record for consecutive top-10 finishes? – **Don January, who had a string of 36 during the 1980-84 seasons.**

Who holds the Champions Tour record for most consecutive eligible events player at 278? – **Dana Quigley (1997/2005).**

Which current Champions Tour players competed in another sport while in college?  
-- **Hale Irwin (football) and Allen Doyle (hockey)**

Four players have won tournaments on the PGA TOUR, Champions Tour and Nationwide Tour. Who are they? – **Ron Streck, Keith Fergus, Tom Lehman and Gary Hallberg.**

Which Champions Tour player holds the record for consecutive holes without a bogey? – **Morris Hatalasky with 98 during the 2003 season.**

Who was the last player to win his next start after claiming a major championship? -- **Jay Haas at the 2008 Principal Charity Classic after winning Senior PGA Championship.**

Which Champions Tour player once caddied for Bruce Fleisher in the late 1960s? – **Allen Doyle.**

Which current Champions Tour players once served as college golf coaches? – **Fred Funk (Maryland) and Keith Fergus (Houston).**
